<p>3-4 February Paul</p> <p>Key Passage: Acts 9:1-31</p>	<p>LESSON: Paul spent much of his time thinking of ways he could help others understand what it meant to follow Jesus with their lives. Paul’s letters help us see that we have battles going on in our mind and that our thoughts have power over the choices we make. <p>10-11 February Thomas</p> <p>Key Passage: John 14:1-7, John 20</p>	<p>LESSON: Thomas was very disappointed because Jesus had died and he had hoped for something different. Even though the disciples told him otherwise, Thomas needed to see Jesus to believe that Jesus was alive. Doubts and lies are thoughts that can overtake us. <p>17-18 February Miriam Encounter</p> <p>Key Passage: Exodus 2:1-10, 15:19-21, Numbers 12</p>	<p>LESSON: Miriam was Moses’ big sister. She had the privilege of supporting him through the Exodus. She had her own purpose as a prophetess and God had a plan for her. Unfortunately, she became jealous of Moses and her bad thinking – and action – found her in an unfavourable position. Miriam’s story reminds us that right thinking matters! <p>24-25 February Martha Communion</p> <p>Key Passage: Luke 10:38-42, John 11:1-44, 12:1-3</p>	<p>LESSON: Martha wanted to please Jesus with doing things for him, but instead, Jesus explained that Mary was doing what was best thing because the most important thing is spending time with Him. This left Martha to think about how her thoughts hadn’t been right or loving. Martha’s story reminds us that our thoughts should be loving toward Jesus and others.
